Providing Health Care in Correctional Settings: *Managing Risks Effectively*

Prisons, jails and community corrections programs are often the only places where offenders get health needs tended to. As corrections professionals, we all have a responsibility to meet the health care needs of the offenders in our care. Linking returning ex-offenders to health care in the community upon discharge is critical.
